

## HSE 215 Journal Guidelines and Rubric

As a human services professional, it is likely that you will work with children in an elementary school or community-based setting. You will not only work with the children, but also with their caregivers and school or organizational personnel. This assignment will help you prepare for these possibilities. You will utilize the knowledge gained from the course thus far, in addition to the text and relevant resources provided, to write a reflective journal assignment about where you would like to make a positive impact in working with a large population of at-risk children in an elementary or community-based setting. Include discussion on the risk and resiliency factors that you are most interested in focusing on as well as why you want to focus on those factors. Reflect on the topics of development that are discussed in the text as well as other readings and the assignments you have completed. This journal is an opportunity for you to share your own personal and professional concerns, insights, and/or excitement that you feel with the idea of working with children in an elementary school or community-based setting. This journal assignment is designed to be **private** between the student and the instructor.

**Prompt:** In your reflective journal assignment, discuss where you think you can have the greatest positive impact in your work as a human services professional in an elementary school or community-based setting with a large population of at-risk students. Specifically, focus on risk and resiliency factors that you would be most interested in addressing and why. Also, share any concerns, worries, or excitement you might have about working with children in an elementary school or community-based setting.

## Specifically, the following critical elements must be addressed:

- Discuss where you think you will have the greatest **impact** in your work as a human services professional in an elementary school or community-based setting with a large population of at-risk students.
- Examine **risk and resiliency factors** that you would focus on with an at-risk population in an elementary school or community-based setting.
- **Reflect** on concerns, worries, and/or excitement about working with this population in an elementary school or community-based setting.

**Guidelines for Submission:** Your journal assignment must be submitted as a one- to two-page Microsoft Word document with double-spacing, 12-point Times New Roman font, one-inch margins, and any sources cited in APA format.
