- What do you think might be a necessary trade policy that has not yet been implemented and why?
- What do you think is the future of trade policies?

Guidelines for Submission: Your case study should be 2–3 pages in length (not including title page and reference page) and written in APA style. Be sure to use scholarly references to support your arguments.
