



INT 640 Short Paper Guidelines and Rubric

Overview: Before starting this assignment, first read this Wharton School article (and watch the accompanying video): [To Buy or Not to Buy: How Increased TV Watching Impacts E-commerce](#). Then write a 2–4 page paper that addresses the following:

- How have **TV viewership** and shopping habits changed?
- Is **traditional cable** (and advertising on cable) a thing of the past?
- How have internet streaming companies such as Netflix, Hulu, and Amazon Prime **marketed** themselves to succeed in this changing environment?
- Is internet streaming the **future**? Explain.

Guidelines for Submission: Your paper must be submitted as a 2–4 page Microsoft Word document with double spacing, 12-point Times New Roman font, one-inch margins, and two to three scholarly sources cited in APA format.
